Forsyth County Government COVID-19 Daily Briefing November 10, 2020

Updated weekdays by approximately 12:30pm

One hundred and six new cases and eight deaths have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 10,156 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All daily cases reported by the State are presumed Forsyth County residents but may later transfer to another county if the case is later identified as not residing in Forsyth County. Of the 10,156, 8,574 are presumed recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the November 12th Board of County Commissioners meeting, which will be conducted remotely. 

- Saturday, Nov. 14, at Shiloh Baptist Church, 916 E. 12th Street, from 9 a.m.-12 p.m.




