# Forsyth County Government COVID-19 Daily Briefing November 16, 2020

Updated weekdays by approximately 12:30pm

There are 76 new cases and three deaths reported today. Over the weekend, there were 178 new cases and four deaths reported on Saturday, and 198 new cases and two deaths reported on Sunday. There have been 11,014 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All daily cases reported by the State are presumed Forsyth County residents but may later transfer to another county if the case is later identified as not residing in Forsyth County. Of the 11,014, 9,071 are presumed recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the November 19th Board of County Commissioners meeting, which will be conducted remotely. The Public Health Director will hold the next Question & Answer session with the media at 4:00pm on November 19th. The call-in information will be sent to the media tomorrow.




#### **Public Health Director Comment**


