COVID-19 Daily Briefing

November 24, 2020

Updated weekdays by approximately 12:30pm

One hundred and forty-five new cases and one death have been reported since yesterday's daily briefing was issued. There have been 12,394 laboratory-confirmed cases in Forsyth County. All daily cases reported by the State are presumed Forsyth County residents but may later transfer to another county if the case is later identified as not residing in Forsyth County. Of the 12,394, 10,033 are presumed recovered. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm on December 3rd at the beginning of the Board of County Commissioners meeting, which will be conducted remotely. Public Health Director Comment

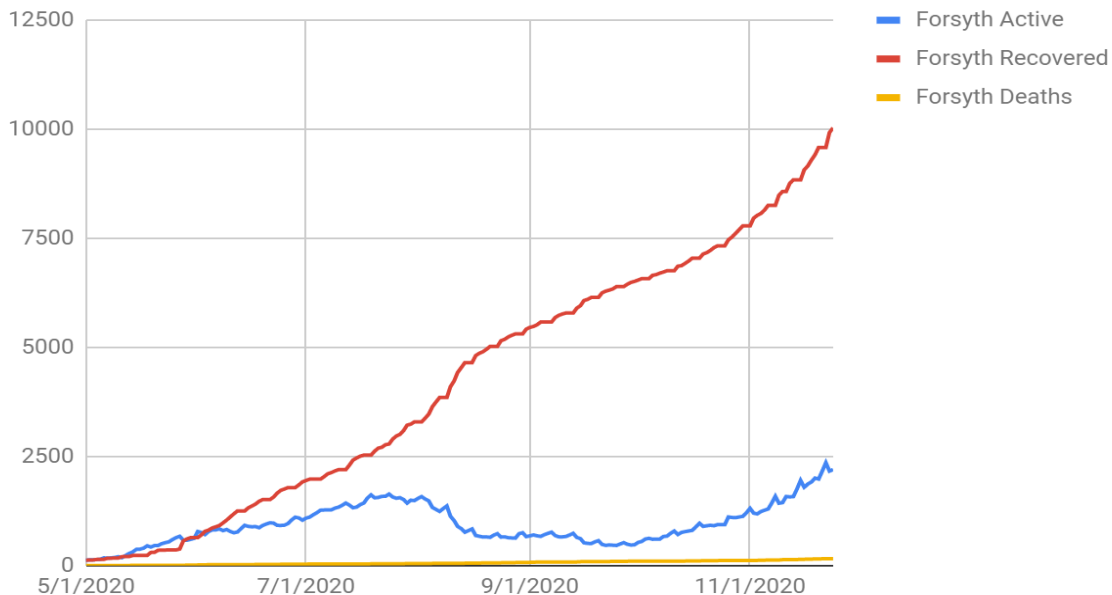
Public Health Director Joshua Swift commented, "The Forsyth County Department of Public Health will host the following no-cost COVID-19 community testing events this week:

- Wednesday, Nov. 25 at Shiloh Baptist Church, 916 E. 12th Street, from 10 a.m.-1 p.m.

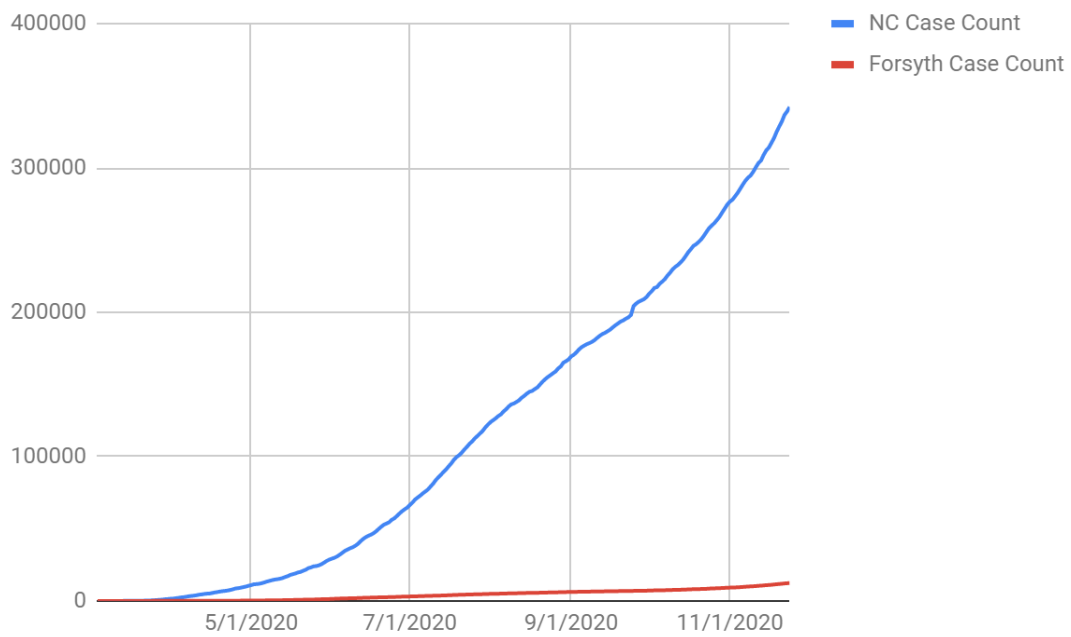
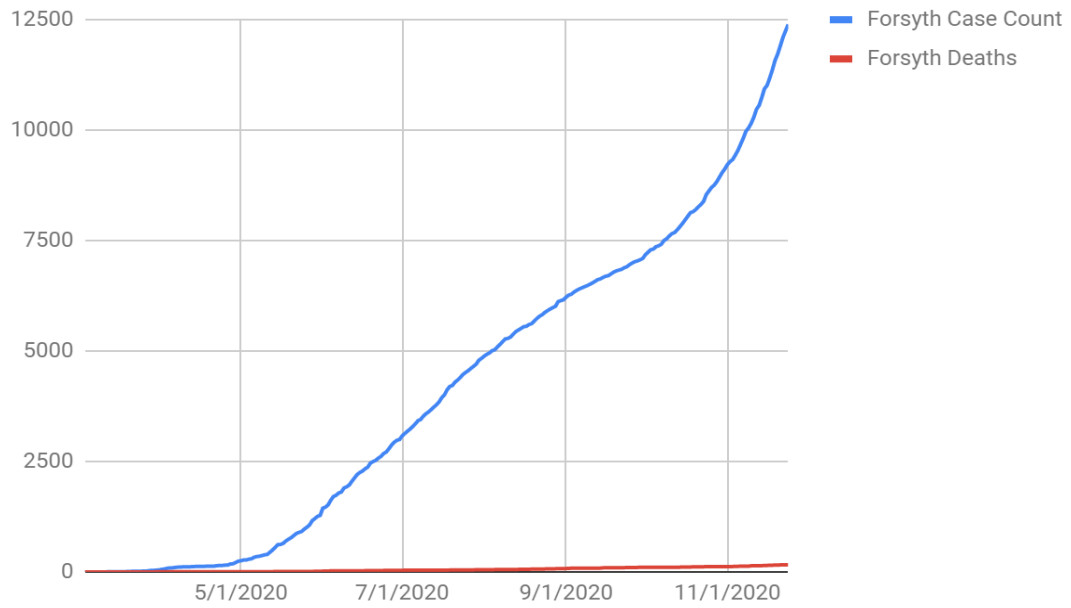
