# Forsyth County Government COVID-19 Daily Briefing January 4, 2021

Updated weekdays by approximately 12:30pm

There are 160 new cases and six deaths reported today. Over the weekend, there were 565 new cases and four deaths reported on Saturday (included cases from Friday), and 159 new cases on Sunday. All daily cases reported by the State are presumed Forsyth County residents but may later transfer to another county if the case is later identified as not residing in Forsyth County. The case count is subject to change throughout the day but will only be reported once per day in the daily briefing.

The Public Health Director will provide a detailed briefing at 2:00pm at the beginning of the January 7<sup>th</sup> Board of County Commissioners meeting, which will be conducted remotely.
